NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), as modified by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 RRS 40 is changed as follows: All competitors are required to wear a life jacket or other adequate personal flotation device while racing.

2. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY, & FEES

- 2.1 The regatta is by invitation only.
- 2.2 Entries will be limited to a maximum of 32 competitors.
- 2.3 Each sailor shall be registered as an ISAF Sailor. The ISAF Sailor number is required to enter the Event. To register as an ISAF sailor go to: <http://www.isaf.org/isafsailor.php>.
- 2.4 Eligible boats shall complete the application online for the Slalom, found at www.sflaserworlds2011.com by **May 1, 2011**.
All applications will be responded to by **June 1, 2011**, being informed by email that:
 - a. An invitation is being offered,
 - b. the application has been added to the waiting list, or
 - c. the application has been declined
- 2.5 Sailors offered an invitation must complete entry on line (www.sflaserworlds2011.com) with the **entry fee of \$125** (U.S. Dollars) by July 1, 2011 to secure the invitation.

3. EQUIPMENT

The organizing authority will supply boats with standard rigs.

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Registration will be 0900-1000 hours on Wednesday, August 3rd.
- 4.2 Racing will be held Wednesday, August 3rd and Thursday, August 4th.
- 4.3 The scheduled time of the first race on Wednesday, August 3rd is 1230 hours. A Sailors' Meeting will be held at 1000 hours on Wednesday, August 3rd at StFYC.
- 4.4 The scheduled time Starting time for the first race on Thursday, August 4th is 1130 hours.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at the StFYC Official Regatta Notice Board on August 1st, while an unofficial copy may be found on the event website (www.sflaserworlds2011.com) prior to that date.

6. RACING AREA

The intended race area will be set on the City Front. Racing will be around a dual slalom course.

7. FORMAT

The event will consist of a double elimination ladder system of 32 competitors. For the first round, competitors will be seeded at the discretion of the organizing authority.

8. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, decision to race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
