NOTICE OF RACE

The notation [DP] in a rule in the NoR means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

The notation '[NP]' in a rule in the NoR means it shall not be grounds for protest by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by the Racing Rules of Sailing, including US Sailing Prescription Appendix U.
- 1.2. [NP] All competitors shall wear a PFD at all times while on the water, other than brief periods while adding or removing clothing. The 'Y' flag will not be flown. This changes RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4.
- 1.3. RRS 48.2 is deleted.
- 1.4. US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 63.2 and 63.4 are deleted.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to : International 14, Nacra 15, 29er, 5o5, Club 420, Laser Radial, Laser, Opti Green, Opti R/W/B, and CFJ boats, whose skipper is a member in good standing of their respective class association.
- 2.2. Eligible boats may enter by submitting the entry form and paying the entry fee online www.stfyc.com, on or before 10/18/17 to avoid late fee penalties. An entry is not considered complete until the entry fee has been paid. All entry fees are non-refundable.
- 2.3. Classes must have a minimum of six boats registered by October 18th in order to qualify for a class start.

- 4.2. [NP] Mandatory Launch Windows: In order to efficiently manage the boat ramp, competitors launching at StFYC are required to adhere to the launching schedule. *Thank you in advance for your cooperation.*

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at or before the competitors' meeting and may also be available online (www.stfyc.com).

6. RACING VENUE & COURSES

- 6.1. Race Venue 1: City Front, north of StFYC
- 6.2. Race Venue 2: West of Alcatraz
- 6.3. Race Venue 3: Cove, east of the SF wave attenuator
- 6.4. The course may be a windward - leeward or any variation of a triangular or other course. Course diagrams will be provided in the sailing instructions.

7. SCORING

- 7.1. One race will constitute a series.
- 7.2. When four (4) or fewer races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 7.3. When five (5) or more races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. This changes RRS A2.

8. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

BOAT & TRAILER STORAGE

All boats competing in the event may be stored free of charge at StFYC during the event as well as one day before and one day after. All boats & trailers shall be stored at the direction of the StFYC Dockmaster.
