NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, including Appendix T.
- 1.2 [DP] All competitors shall wear an approved PFD at all times while on the water, other than brief periods while adding or removing clothing, or below deck. The 'Y' flag will not be flown. This changes RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4.
- 1.3 RRS 48.2 is deleted.
- 1.4 US Sailing Prescriptions 63.2 and 63.4 are deleted.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all Pac52 boats whose skipper is a member in good standing with their respective class association.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by submitting the entry form and paying the entry fee online www.stfyc.com, on or before 1159 Sunday 9/24/17. An entry is not considered complete until the entry fee has been paid. All entry fees are non-refundable.

3 FEES

The entry fee is \$300.

4 SCHEDULE

A maximum of (8) eight races will be sailed.

Races will be sailed on the San Francisco Bay City Front.

7 SCORING

- 7.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 7.2 A boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores.

The race organizers (OA, Ratings Authority, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

9 PRIZES

Take home prizes will be awarded based on participation.

10 BOAT & TRAILER STORAGE

All boats competing in the event may be stored free of charge at StFYC during the event as well as one day before and one day after. If you plan on leaving a trailer in the City parking lot, you need to obtain an overnight parking permit from the StFYC Race Office at the price of \$8 per day. All boats & trailers shall be stored at the direction of the StFYC Dockmaster.
