

NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta shall be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, including *Appendix C*.
- 1.2 The organizing authority (OA) shall be St. Francis Yacht Club.
- **1.3** Rules for boats, equipment and handling of boats will be distributed as part of the sailing instructions. Spinnakers will be used when conditions permit as determined by the race committee.
- 1.4 Racing rule 40 will be changed as follows: All competitors must wear personal flotation while racing.

2 BOATS

- **2.1** J/22-type boats will be provided by the organizing authority.
- **2.2** Teams may furnish spinnakers that meet Class specifications.

3 DIVISIONS, ELIGIBILITY & CREW

- 3.1 The regatta is an invitational open to skippers & crew who are current undergraduates or alumni from Cal or Stanford. One team for each division are eligible are as follows:
 - 1) Current sailing team members from Cal and Stanford

Age limits in effect for alumni divisions at date of regatta are as follows:

- 2) Young Alumni (39 and under)
- 3) Masters Alumni (40 59)
- 4) Grandmasters Alumni (60 and up)
- **3.2** Current school sailing team boats shall have a crew of four, including the skipper.
- **3.3** For alumni divisions boats shall have a crew minimum of three, but no more than four, including the skipper.
- **3.4** No crew weight limits will be in effect.
- **3.5** Teams will be assigned by team captains listed in NOR 8.

4 ENTRY

- **4.1** The entry fee is \$150.00 per each division team.
- 4.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at www.stfyc.com. Entries are due by November 11th, 2014. After this date a \$75 late fee will be assessed.
- **4.3** Boats will be available for practice on November 15th and 16th at an additional charter fee of \$150.00 per day, per boat.
- 4.4 Skippers shall enter a boat charter agreement. A refundable damage deposit of \$1,500 is required upon entry confirmation, payable via credit card authorization. The amount of the initial damage deposit is the maximum payable by a team for each damage-causing incident for which the team is deemed to be responsible by the OA. The OA may require the damage deposit to be replenished after any damage-causing incident and prior to any further racing. Any remaining deposit after the event will be refunded.

5 EVENT FORMAT & SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- **5.1** The sailing instructions will be available at the check-in before the skippers meeting.
- **5.2** A mandatory skippers meeting will be held at StFYC at 1000 hours on November 18th.
- **5.3** The intended format is a best-of-three (First to win 2 points) in each division.
- **5.4** One race will constitute a series for each division.

6 RACING AREA

Races will be conducted on the San Francisco City Front.

7 SOCIAL & AWARDS

- **7.1** Guests are welcome to attend the event luncheon held concurrently in the club. Contact the front desk at 415-563-6363 for information and reservations.
- 7.2 Competitors and their guests are invited to an awards ceremony in the club immediately after racing.
