# **NOTICE OF RACE**

The St. Francis Yacht Club and Stanford Varsity Sailing Team are pleased to welcome you to the twentieth annual St. Francis Interconference Regatta. Get excited for plenty of wind and great surfing conditions on the San Francisco City Front!

#### 1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the ICSA Procedural Rules, except any of these that are modified by this Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions.

#### 2. HOST & VENUE

The regatta will be hosted by the St. Francis Yacht Club & Stanford University, and will be sailed out of St. Francis Yacht Club. For a map and directions enter "St. Francis Yacht Club" on Google Maps.

#### 3. ELIGIBILITY & FORMAT

One Coed Varsity and one Women's Varsity team may enter from each ICSA member school previously approved by the ICSA Interconference Coordinator. There will not be a JV division at this event. Depending on the number of entries, the Coed and Women's fleets may be sailed separately.

#### 5. BOATS

Each team shall supply their own PCCSC/CFJ class legal FJ and sails with PCCSC numbers on them. There will be no boat rotation; teams will sail their own boat for the duration of the regatta. Teams requiring charters should contact Bay Area PCCSC schools.

### 6. RACING AREA

Races will be conducted on the San Francisco City Front, either directly north of StFYC or just east of the breakwater between Fort Mason and the San Francisco Marina.

## 7. BOAT & TRAILER STORAGE

All boats & trailers should be stored in the parking lot east of StFYC, at the direction of the Dock Master. If you plan on leaving a trailer in the City parking lot, an overnight parking permit may need to be obtained from the StFYC Race Office during registration. Trailers without a city permit may be towed.

### 8. HOUSING

Competitors are responsible for their own accommodations.
