

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

AMENDMENT #1

SI 11 is deleted and replaced with the following:

11 UMPIRING, PROTESTS, REDRESS

- **11.1** Umpiring will be in accordance with RRS D2. RRS D2.5 will apply. D2.5C is changed as follows: "If the protested boat fails to respond, the protesting boat may request a decision by conspicuously displaying a Y flag and hailing 'Umpire'.
- **11.2** For protests and requests for redress other than protests under a rule listed in RRS D2.5, competitors shall inform an umpire or the RC within two minutes of finishing.
- **11.3** The umpires shall, when appropriate, attempt to hear protests and requests for redress while afloat. If a protest or redress hearing ashore is necessary, the time, place and nature of the hearing shall be posted on the official notice boards no later than 30 minutes after the RC signal boat docks.
