NOTICE OF RACE

1.0 RULES

- **1.1** The regatta will be governed by this Notice of Race and the Racing Instructions.
- 1.2 Competitors shall wear flotation and insulation adequate for water temperatures as low as 50° F.

2.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- **2.1** The regatta is open to all Stand Up Paddleboarders in the following divisions: 12.6 Stock, 14, Unlimited, and SUP (under 12.6).
- **2.2.** Eligible competitors may enter by completing the online entry form located at www.stfyc.com. Entries must be received by the Wednesday prior to racing in order to take advantage of the discounted entry fee.

3.0 FEES

- **3.1** Entry fee is \$30, if received *prior* to the Wednesday before racing (February 19, March 19, April 23).
- **3.2.** Entry fee is \$40 if received after the Wednesday before racing.

6.0 RACING AREA

Races will be conducted on the San Francisco City Front between Blackaller Buoy and Aquatic Park.

7.0 SCORING

7.1 One race must be completed to constitute a series.
