RACING INSTRUCTIONS

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by these Racing Instructions and the Notice of Race.
- 1.2. Competitors shall wear flotation and insulation adequate for water temperatures as low as 50° F.

2. COMMUNICATION WITH COMPETITORS

- 2.1. A Mandatory Competitors' Meeting will be held at St. Francis Yacht Club at 0900 hours.
- 2.2. Official Notices will be posted on the Official Regatta Notice Board located in the hallway adjacent to the side (Regatta) entrance of StFYC.
- 2.3. Changes to the Racing Instructions will be posted by 0900 hours on the day they are to take effect.
- 2.4. Oral changes to the Racing Instructions may be made on the water. A change is in effect when the RC signal boat displays code flag L over A with one sound signal. This means "come within hail" of the RC Signal Boat to receive oral changes to the Racing Instructions. The Race Committee may give oral changes to the Racing Instructions to each boat by loud hailer and require acknowledgement.

3. SCHEDULE OF RACES

Racing will be at 0930 hours.

4. RACING AREA

Races will be conducted on the San Francisco City Front.

5. COURSES AND MARKS

The courses and marks are described below.

6. THE START & FINISH LINES

The start and finish line will be on the beach just west of St. Francis Yacht Club.

7. TIME LIMIT

The Time Limit for each race is 90 minutes. A competitor failing to finish within 90 minutes, or within 30 minutes after the first competitor in her class completes the course and finishes, will be scored DNF by the Race Committee. This changes RRS 35.

8. SCORING

One race must be completed to constitute a series.

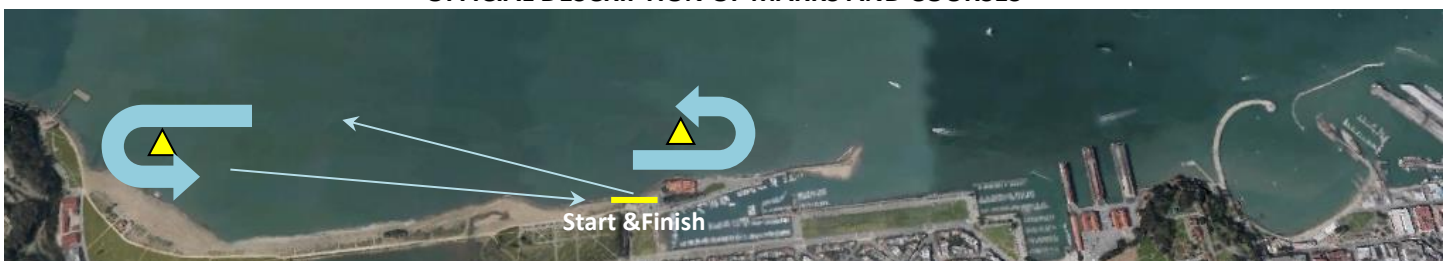
9. DISPOSAL OF WASTE OR TRASH

Competitors shall not dispose of waste or trash in the bay. Competitors observed breaking this rule are subject to disqualification from the race.

10. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded based on class participation.

OFFICIAL DESCRIPTION OF MARKS AND COURSES



2 mile course = 1x 2 mile course (left shoulder turns)

4 mile course = 2x 2 mile course (left shoulder turns)

6 mile course = 3x 2 mile course (left shoulder turns)
