### NOTICE OF RACE

#### 1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS), including *Appendix F*.
- 1.2 Except for Kiteboard and Windsurf classes RRS 40 is changed as follows: Competitors shall wear personal floatation devices while racing.
- 1.3 Competitors in the Kiteboard and Windsurf classes shall wear wetsuits with a minimum thickness of 3/2mm, which covers the knees and has short sleeves as minimum coverage.
- 1.4 The *Sailing Instructions* may change other rules.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The following classes are invited to participate: 29er, 49er, 49erFX, 505, Club 420, F18, Finn, Formula Windsurf, Formula Kite, Hydrofoil Kite, Laser 4.7, Laser Radial, Laser Standard, Vanguard 15 and Weta.
- 2.2 All Laser 4.7, Radial, and Standard competitors shall furnish proof of membership in the International Laser Class Association.
- 2.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at [www.stfyc.com](http://www.stfyc.com). Entries must be received by April 28, 2015 to take advantage of the discounted entry fee.
- 2.4 Fleets must have six boats registered by April 28, 2015 to qualify for a class start.

#### 3. FEES

- 3.1 For singlehanded classes, entry fee is \$65 **if received by April 28, 2015**.
- 3.2 For double-handed classes, entry fee is \$95 **if received by April 28, 2015**.
- 3.3 A late fee of \$25 will be assessed to all entries **received on or after April 29, 2015**.

#### 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

#### 6. RACING AREA

The intended race area will be set on the City Front utilizing inflatable marks.

#### 7. SCORING

- 7.1 One race shall constitute a series.

**7.2** If fewer than five races are completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores. If five or more races are completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. This changes RRS A2.

**7.3** For all Laser classes this event is worth 20 Grand Prix points in the Laser District 24 Championship series. Details at [www.laser.org](http://www.laser.org).
