NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 One Design J/105 Fleet One rules will be in effect.
- 1.3 One Design J/111 Fleet Five rules will be in effect.
- 1.4 One Design J/120 Fleet Five rules will be in effect.
- 1.5 RRS 40 is changed as follows: Competitors shall wear personal flotation devices while racing, except when below deck or briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 This regatta is open to the following one-design classes: J/111, J/120, J/105.
- 2.2 This regatta is open to the following handicap divisions for yachts 33' LOA and above:
 - a) Multihull Handicap with valid BAMA certificate, rating of -45 or faster and minimum of 33 feet LOA, including pole
 - b) HPR with a valid HPR certificate
 - c) ORR with an ORR Partial Measurement certificate
 - d) PHRF with a valid PHRF certificateAdditional classes may be added at the discretion of the organizing authority.
- 2.3 Final division assignments will be posted on the StFYC Official Notice Board by 1700 hours on Friday, May 15th.
- 2.4 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at www.stfyc.com. Entries must be received by Wednesday, May 13th in order to take advantage of the discounted entry fee.
- 2.5 One design classes must have a minimum of **six boats registered by May 13th** in order to qualify for a one-design class start. Boats in fleets with fewer than six boats are welcome to enter one of the handicap divisions assuming they meet the certificate requirements listed above.

3 FEES

Entry fee is \$180 **if received by May 13th**. A late fee of \$50 will be assessed to entries **received after May 14th or later**.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at StFYC and posted at www.stfyc.com by May 16th.

6 RACING AREA

The intended race area will be set on the San Francisco Central Bay utilizing inflatable marks and/or fixed marks.

7 SCORING

- 7.1** One race will constitute a series.
7.2 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. This changes RRS A2.

8 PRIZES

- 8.1** Prizes will be award based on participation. The Phyllis Kleinman Swiftsure Cup will be awarded to the ORR boat with the best overall score based on corrected time (using the Time on Time method) sailed in each race.
8.2 A trophy will also be awarded to the boat with the "best dressed crew".

9 BERTHING

All yachts competing in the event may be moored free of charge at the StFYC guest docks one night prior to the beginning of racing and one night after racing concludes. All boats shall be moored at the direction of the StFYC Dockmaster.

10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors shall participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk (see RRS 4, DECISION TO RACE). The Organizing Authority does not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.
