NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 The measurement rule of the International 6 Meter Class will apply.
- 1.3 RRS 40 will be changed as follows: Competitors shall wear personal flotation devices while racing, except when below deck or briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. The Sailing Instructions may change other rules.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to boats and skippers invited by the organizing authority.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form located at www.stfyc.com.
- 2.3 Entry deadline is Friday, September 25.

3 DIVISIONS

Boats will assigned to divisions of comparable rule generations and race as a level class.

4 FEES

Entry fee is \$300 if received prior to Wednesday, September 30, 2015, and \$350.00 if received thereafter.

7 RACE AREA AND COURSES

The race area will be set on the San Francisco City Front utilizing inflatable and permanent marks.

8 SCORING

8.1 One race must be completed to constitute a series.

8.2 Eight (8) races are scheduled in the series, all of which will count towards a boat's final score. This changes RRS A2.

9 BERTHING

Yachts competing in the event may be moored free of charge at the StFYC guest docks beginning Sunday, October 4 through Sunday, October 11.
