



Code of Conduct and Safety Agreement

While we think that you will have an amazing and fun experience; it is important that we all start the class with the same expectations. In order to ensure that everyone has a safe experience and that the class does not disrupt the Clubhouse atmosphere, we have set forth the following rules:

- The boat/board that you are using will be your responsibility. You will be held financially responsible for replacement parts and repairs necessary as a result of neglect.
- Life jackets and wetsuits **MUST** be worn while on the dock and in a boat/on a board.
- Sailing is a potentially dangerous activity which includes the risk of head injuries as a result of contact with the boom or other boat part. Though not required by the StFYC for this program, sailing-specific helmets are available for purchase from several vendors including West Coast Sailing, APS Sailing Outfitters, and Murrays.com.. St. Francis Yacht Club does not provide sailing helmets.
- Bullying or any other form of disrespectful behavior toward other classmates will not be tolerated.
- Dangerous behavior will not be tolerated.
- Instructors/Coaches must be obeyed at all times. Disrespectful behavior towards the instructors will not be tolerated.
- No foul language.
- Verbal and physical arguments are prohibited.
- Shoes must be worn at all times.
- Each participant is expected to pass a swim test at the start of each class that includes an unaided 25 yard swim and treading water.
- St. Francis Yacht Club House Rules require that gentlemen remove their hats or caps in the Clubhouse
- Cell phone use is prohibited inside the Clubhouse
- Participants must be picked up within 15min. of the scheduled end time of each class. Parents and or Guardians of participants left unattended beyond the 15 min. grace period will be charged \$1 per minute fee due upon arrival. Failure to pay fee and or repeated offences will be grounds for participant's removal from the program.

Should any of the above rules be broken, sailors will be subject to consequences, depending upon the severity of the incident. These may include a warning, trash-duty (or other similar activity), or time-out. If the instructors determine that a child has become detrimental to the functioning of the program, that child will be sent home. Please ensure that somebody (either yourself or the emergency contact given on the medical form) will be reachable during the hours your sailor is with us.

**Parent's Consent and Waiver of Liability,
Assumption of Risk & Indemnity Agreement**

The undersigned parents or legal guardians (hereafter referred to in the singular) of _____ (herein referred to as "Child"), request that my Child be allowed to participate at any St. Francis Yacht Club Junior Activities (herein referred to as the "Activities"). This agreement shall remain in effect until St. Francis Yacht Club Junior Committee receives written notice of the cancellation of the consent or until the end of the Activities described above.

In return for my Child being permitted to take part in the Activities and to use the facilities and property of any St. Francis Yacht Club facility each of us makes the following promises and warrants the truth of the following facts:

- 1) I am familiar with the programs included in the Activities, and I understand officers and employees of any St. Francis Yacht Club are available to discuss the Activities if I should wish additional information. I also understand I am solely responsible for the arrival and departure of my Child at the beginning and end of the Activities. I will not allow my Child to remain on the premises of any St. Francis Yacht Club after the Activities without appropriate supervision or the written permission of the Yacht Club. I agree St. Francis Yacht Club will have no responsibility for the supervision of my Child at times other than during the scheduled Activities. I will inform my Child that he/she is expected to cooperate with, and follow the directions of, the persons in charge of the Activities, to abide by the Code of Conduct and Safety Agreement and to act in a manner consistent with the spirit of good sportsmanship and respect for the rights of others.
- 2) My Child is in good health, and I know of no reason why he/she would be incapable of participating in the Activities. My Child knows how to swim. I will immediately notify the designated St. Francis Yacht Club supervisor, if a change in my Child's health or other condition would affect my Child's ability to participate in the Activities.
- 3) **WAIVER OF LIABILITY.** I waive and release any rights I, my heirs, distributees, guardians, legal representatives and assigns may have or acquire to make a claim against, sue, attach the property of or prosecute the St. Francis Yacht Club or any of its members, directors, officers, agents, volunteers, attorneys, employees and affiliated organizations (herein referred to as "the Releasees") for monetary damages caused by injury to my Child or myself or damage to the property of my Child or myself arising from my Child's participation in the Activities and use of the facilities and property of the St. Francis Yacht Club, whether or not the injury or damage results from the negligence or other action, except intentional acts, of any of the Releasees. **(Please initial to indicate you have read this paragraph. _____)**
- 4) **ASSUMPTION OF RISK.** I am aware that the Activities may involve maneuvering a boat, sailboard or other watercraft on deep waters in potentially hazardous conditions which may include, among other things, strong wind and high waves, sudden and unexpected immersion in deep waters and collision with other watercraft or stationary objects such as docks, pilings and buoys. With knowledge of the dangers involved, I voluntarily ask that my Child be allowed to take part in the Activities. I ACCEPT ANY AND ALL RISKS TO MYSELF AND MY CHILD OF INJURY, DEATH AND PROPERTY DAMAGE ARISING FROM PARTICIPATION IN THE ACTIVITIES AND THE USE OF THE FACILITIES AND PROPERTY OF THE ST. FRANCIS YACHT CLUB, WHETHER OR NOT CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OR OTHER ACTION, EXCEPT INTENTIONAL ACTS, OF ANY OF THE RELEASEES. **(Please initial to indicate you have read this paragraph. _____)**
- 5) **INDEMNITY AGREEMENT.** I agree to indemnify, defend and hold the Releasees harmless from any loss, liability, actual damage, consequential damage, or cost, including reasonable attorneys fees, they may incur due to my Child's participation in the Activities whether or not such loss, liability, damage or cost results from the negligence or other action, except intentional acts, of any of the Releasees. **(Please initial to indicate you have read this paragraph. _____).**

I HAVE CAREFULLY READ THIS AGREEMENT AND FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS CONTENTS. I AM AWARE THE AGREEMENT INCLUDES A WAIVER OF LIABILITY, AN ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND AN AGREEMENT BY ME TO INDEMNIFY THE RELEASEES, AND I SIGN IT OF MY OWN FREE WILL.
