## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1. RULES

The regatta shall be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), including Appendix B - Windsurfing Competition Rules, except as any of these are altered by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 Windsurfers are invited to attend.

2.2 Eligible sailors shall register by completing the online entry form at [www.stfyc.com](http://www.stfyc.com).

2.3 Early registration is strongly encouraged: **A participant must be entered in the *Season Series* prior to the start of the second scheduled race to be eligible for season scoring.**

2.4 Registration for the *Season Series* will close on **June 3, 2016**. All *Season Series* entries after this date will be subject to the approval of the race committee, and will be ineligible for season scoring.

2.5 Participants not entered in the *Season Series* are invited to race as a *Drop In*. Such participants may register for *Drop In* racing by completing online registration and paying the entry fee. This must be done by BEFORE racing for that evening begins.

2.6 Participants entered in the *Season Series* are required to serve on the race committee one evening to be eligible for season scoring.

### 3. FEES

Entry fee is \$75 for the *Season Series*, or \$25 per evening to race as a *Drop In*.

### 4. SCHEDULE

4.1 The first warning signal each night is scheduled for 1730 hours.

4.2 Racing will be held on the following dates: May 20, June 3, July 8 & August 26.

### 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be posted at [www.stfyc.com](http://www.stfyc.com) and copies will be available at the StFYC Race Office.

### 6. RACING AREA

The intended race area will be the City Front utilizing both fixed and dropped marks.

### 7. SCORING

7.1 A description of the scoring system will be outlined in the sailing instructions.

7.2 Series competitors attending the rules seminar on May 12th at 1730 will receive first place points. Series competitors not in attendance at the rules seminar on May 12th will receive points equal to DNC.

### 8. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors shall participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk (see Rule 4, DECISION TO RACE). The organizing authority does not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.
