NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 RRS 40 will be changed as follows: Competitors shall wear personal flotation devices while racing, except when below deck or briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment.
- 1.3 Appendix T, Section A, T1 PENALTIES AT THE TIME OF THE INCIDENT (One-Turn Penalty) shall apply.
- 1.4 IOD One Design: *Regulations Governing the International One Design Class, San Francisco Fleet* will apply.
- 1.5 For the Knarr Class the *SFBKA Articles of Association* are in effect.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 This regatta is open to boats of the following classes: Bird, Folkboat, IOD, and Knarr.
- 2.2 Each class must have 6 boats registered by June 22, 2016 to guarantee a separate Class start.
- 2.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form located at www.stfyc.com.

3 FEES

- 3.1 The entry fee is \$180.
- 3.2 Any entry or payment for an entry received on or after June 22 will incur an additional fee of \$20.
- 3.3 An entry is not considered complete until the online entry form and fee are received.

- 4.2 For all classes: up to 3 races are scheduled for Saturday and up to 2 races are scheduled for Sunday.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at the StFYC official regatta notice board by 1200 hours on Friday, June 24 and may also be posted online at www.stfyc.com.

6 RACING AREA

The race area will be set on the San Francisco City Front utilizing inflatable and permanent marks.

7 SCORING

- 7.1 One race must be completed for each class to constitute a series for that class.
- 7.2 For all classes: all races will count towards the boat's final score. This changes RRS A2.

8 BERTHING

Yachts competing in the event may be moored free of charge at the StFYC guest docks following racing on the preceding Wednesday night until one night after racing concludes.

9 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors shall participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk (see RRS 4, DECISION TO RACE). The Organizing Authority does not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.
