NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 Racing rule 40 will be changed as follows: Competitors shall wear personal flotation devices while racing, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment.
- 1.3 One Design J/120 Fleet One Rules will apply.
- 1.4 One Design J/111 Fleet Five Rules will apply.
- 1.5 One Design J/105 Class Rules will apply.
- 1.6 One Design J/88 Class Rules will apply.
- 1.7 One Design J/80 Class Rules will apply.
- 1.8 One Design J/70 Class Rules will apply.
- 1.9 One Design J/24 Class Rules will apply.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The event is open only to yachts produced by J/Boats (J/24, J/70, J/80, J/88, J/105, J/111, J/120, etc.).
- 2.2 Eligible competitors may enter online at www.stfyc.com before Saturday, April 1st.

3 DIVISIONS

- 3.1 One Design: (J/24, J/70, J/80, J/88, J/105, J/111, J/120, etc.) will have separate class starts provided six boats are registered by March 29th.
- 3.2 Classes with less than six boats may have combined starts at the discretion of the race committee.

4 FEES

- 4.1 For Boats 30' and under, the entry fee is \$145.
- 4.2 For Boats 31' and over, the entry fee is \$195.
- 4.3 An entry is not considered complete until the online entry form and fee are received.
- 4.4 Entries received on or after March 29th will incur an additional fee of \$50.

7 RACING AREA

The intended racing area will be set on the San Francisco City Front.

8 SCORING

- 8.1 One race will constitute a series.
- 8.2 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. This changes RRS A2.

BOAT & TRAILER STORAGE

All yachts competing in the event may be berthed free of charge at the StFyc guest docks one night prior to the beginning of racing and one night after racing concludes. All boats and trailers shall be stored at the direction of the StFyc Dockmaster or Race Coordinator.
