NOTICE OF RACE

The notation [NP] in a rule in the NOR means it shall not be grounds for protest by a boat This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, and Appendix V.
- 1.2. All competitors shall wear a PFD at all times while on the water, other than brief periods while adding or removing clothing, or below deck. The 'Y' flag will not be flown. This changes RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4. [NP]
- 1.3. RRS 48.2 is deleted.
- 1.4. US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 63.2 and 63.4 are deleted.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The race is open to monohull boats with a LOA greater than 28' and a current fully or partially measured ORR rating certificate and/or a PHRF rating.
- 2.2. Double handed Express 27s and double handed Moore 24s can qualify for a start and race under a PHRF rating.
- 2.3. Classes must have a minimum of six (6) boats registered by August 12 to qualify for a start.
- 2.4. Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at www.stfyc.com on or before 1700 Thursday, August 20.
- 2.5. An entry is not considered complete until the entry form has received.

3. SCHEDULE

The first warning signal will be at 1125.

4. FEES

- 4.1 The entry fee is \$50.
- 4.2 The entry fee is waived if you are entered in the Phyllis Kleinmann Swiftsure Regatta August 22-23.

5. DIVISION ASSIGNMENTS & SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1. Division assignments (as required) will be posted on the StFYC Official Notice Board by 1700 Thursday, August 20.
- 5.2. The sailing instructions will be available on or before 1700 Thursday, August 20 online at www.stfyc.com and at the StFYC official race notice board.

6. COURSE

The race committee intends to conduct a single distance race utilizing San Francisco Bay and its approaches.

7. TIME LIMIT

- 7.1. The time limit for the race will be five (5) hours.
- 7.2. Boats failing to finish within 120 minutes after the first finisher will be scored Did Not Finish (DNF) without a hearing. This changes RRS 35, A4 and A5.

8. SCORING

A boat's corrected time will be calculated using her San Francisco Bay TCF.

9. PENALTY SYSTEM

RRS Appendix V – Alternative Penalties will apply for all boats.

10. AWARDS

- 10.1. Prizes will be awarded based on participation.
- 10.2. The Aldo Alessio Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to first place finisher in the ORR Division.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Ratings Authority, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any kite or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this regatta. By participating in this regatta, each

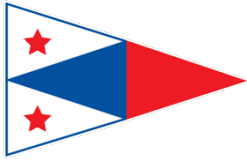
competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

BOAT & TRAILER STORAGE AT STFYC

- Docking is available for boats one (1) day prior and one (1) day after the regatta, at no cost. Additional days may be permitted by the Dockmaster. For more information about docking, [please visit our website](#).
- Overnight parking permits are required for trailers. Trailers permits must be purchased during the online entry process and can be picked up at the StFYC Race Office prior to the competitors' meeting.
- Overnight parking for cars is not permitted by the City of San Francisco Parks & Recreation Department.
- All boats & trailers shall be stored at the direction of the StFYC Dockmaster or Race Office.
