US MATCH RACING CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIER – MAY 1-2

This two-day event brought seven teams to compete head-to-head in a round-robin of 12 races each in the StFYC set of matched J/22 boats. Both days presented significant challenges to the Race Committee, as winds rose from 5 to 30 kts, and the wind direction cycled up to 30 degrees and back. The Signals Team anchored at the start line in the Cressy, and two markset boats covered the weather and leeward marks.
