NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2** All competitors are required to wear a life jacket or other adequate personal floatation device while racing. RRS 40 is changed as follows: The "Y" flag will not be displayed.
- 1.3** Appendix T1 will apply. The first two sentences of rule 44.1 are changed to: "A boat may take a One-Turn Penalty when she may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 in an incident while racing or rule 31. However, when she may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 in an incident while in the zone around a mark other than a starting mark, her penalty shall be a Two-Turns Penalty."
- 1.4** The following US Sailing prescriptions will not apply: 60, 63.2 and 63.4.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1** The series is open to all boats of the J22 class.
- 2.2** Entrants must enter online (www.stfyc.com).
- 2.3** Registration for the *Series* will open at 1200hrs on **Friday, June 27**.
- 2.4** Single-night entries ("drop-ins") will be allowed. Single-night entries must enter online (www.stfyc.com) by 1600 hours on the evening they plan to participate.

3 FEES

- 3.1** Entry fee is \$100 for the *Series*.
- 3.2** Entry fee for single night entries ("drop-ins") is \$25.
- 3.3** The *Series* charter fee for a StFYC club J22 is \$450.
- 3.4** If available, a single night charter fee for a StFYC club J22 is \$100.

4 CHARTERED BOATS

- 4.1** Chartered boats will be assigned for the duration of the series on a first come, first served basis according to the online registration time stamp.
- 4.2** If available, chartered boats will be assigned for a single-night charter on a first come, first served basis according to emailed requests to racing@stfyc.com.
- 4.3** Club J22s may be chartered by a "primary skipper" who is a member in good standing of St. Francis Yacht Club and is an approved skipper.
- 4.4** The "primary skipper" may designate one "alternate skipper" who is a member in good standing of St. Francis Yacht Club and is an approved skipper.
- 4.5** Either the "primary" or "alternate skipper" must be onboard at all times.
- 4.6** Crew on chartered boats may be StFYC members or non-members.

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1** The first Warning Signal each night is scheduled for 1745 hours.
- 5.2** The Race Committee will attempt to run 3-4 races each night.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available at StFYC and on the website (www.stfyc.com) no later than July 9.

7 RACING AREA

The intended race area will be set on the City Front utilizing both fixed and dropped marks.

8 SCORING

8.1 The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply including RRS A9, Race Scores In A Series Longer Than A Regatta.

8.2 Three races shall constitute a *Series*.

8.3 When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. When 12 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores. When 12 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her three worst scores.

9 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors shall participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk (see Rule 4, DECISION TO RACE). The organizing authority does not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.

10 PRIZES

A nightly prize will be awarded to 1st place boat each evening of racing. Overall prizes will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place boats in the series.
